



CRITERIA FOR DE DEPLOYMENT OF THE UDL ACADEMIC MOBILITY REGULATIONS TO THE DEGREES AND DOUBLE DEGREE COURSES OF THE FACULTAT D'INFERMERIA I FISIOTERÀPIA

(Approved by agreement no. 291/2023 of the Governing Council of October 24, 2023)

The objective of these regulations is to facilitate the application of the UdL's International Academic Mobility Regulations for Students, approved by Agreement No. 139/2023 of the Consell de Govern of May 2, 2023, to the degree and double degrees of the Facultat d'Infermeria i Fisioteràpia.

Outgoing Mobility Students

Formalization of the Study Contract (Art. 20)

Before authorizing a study contract, the mobility coordinator will review compliance with the following criteria:

- a) Mandatory courses must have a sufficient level of correspondence with the content and credit allocation at the destination institution. To meet this requirement, they can be taken at multiple courses at the destination university.
- b) Elective courses must be related to the student's orientation and curriculum.
- c) The Degree's Final Project at the destination university must have equivalent characteristics to those that appear in the current study plans at the FIF, including the writing of the thesis and the oral and public defense before an evaluation committee
- d) External Curricular Academic Internships (must have a duration equivalent to that specified in the FIF study plan
- e) Students on mobility (both from Igualada-UdL campus and the Lleida Campus) who are unable to attend the mandatory skills classes for clinical practice will be required to take them on the dates scheduled by the FIF (preferably during July).

Number of credits that can be included in the study contract (Art. 21)

In Degrees, the minimum number of credits that can be recognized is 45 ECTS for annual mobility and 24 ECTS for semester mobility.

In Double Degrees, the minimum number of credits that can be recognized is 56 ECTS for annual mobility and 31 ECTS for semester mobility.

In accordance with article 21 of the Regulations for International Academic Mobility for Students at the Universitat de Lleida, exceptionally, study contracts may be authorized that include a lower number of credits when this represents the total number of credits not exceeded to obtain the degree.

Conversion of Grades (Art. 25)

For the conversion of grades obtained in mobility, the mobility coordinator will apply the following criteria:

- a) Grades at the UdL will be based exclusively on the grade obtained at the destination university.



- b) When the grade is PASS/FAIL, the conversion to a numerical grade will be done by calculating the weighted average of the grades in the rest of the transcript.
- c) In the case of the Final Degree Project, the student must submit a copy of this work with the data of the supervising professor at the destination university.
- d) For External Curricular Academic Internships, the student must submit a report on the activity carried out, signed by the mobility coordinator of the destination university.

Incoming exchange students

Academic Offer (Art. 31)

Incoming exchange students at the FIF will not be able to take annual subjects in the case of a semester exchange, except for External Curricular Academic Internships.

In subjects with more than one teaching group, the student will be assigned the shift (group) based on the availability of places

Transitional Provision

These regulations apply to all incoming and outgoing exchange students as of the 2023-24 academic year.

Additional Provisions

In case of conflict between these regulations and the Regulations on International Academic Mobility for Students at the Universitat de Lleida, the latter shall always prevail.
